EASY

LEARN TO KNIT COWL

MATERIALS

- US 15 knitting needles
- 100 yards bulky weight yarn, such as Lamb's Pride Bulky (85% Wool, 15% Mohair; 125 yds; 4oz)
- Tapestry needle

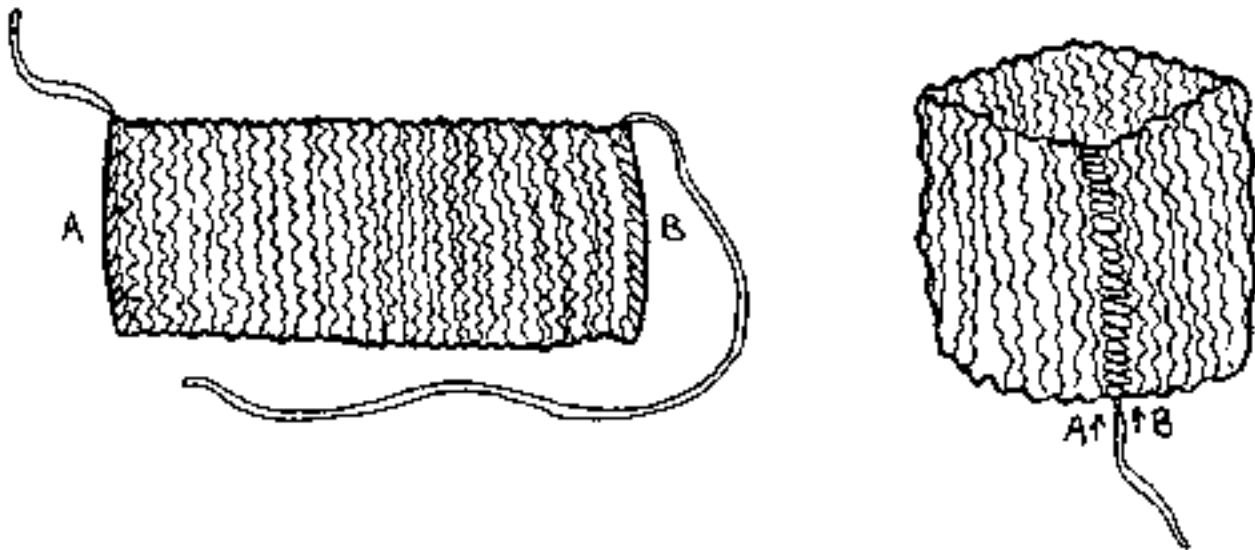
MAKE THE COWL

Note: This cowl is made by knitting a long rectangle. Once the rectangle is long enough to circle your neck comfortably, you'll bind off and sew the short ends together to create a loop.

Cast on 18 stitches.

Work in garter stitch (knit every row) until piece measures approximately 24", or to desired length. Be sure to leave enough yarn for binding off and sewing your seam (about 6 to 8 yards).

Bind off all stitches. You'll have a pretty long tail left after binding off- thread this onto your tapestry needle and use it to sew the short ends of your rectangle together. Weave in ends.
